Andrea was a member of Antioch Baptist Church for most of her life and faithfully served as a Deaconess, Superintendent of Sunday School and Sunday School teacher, to name a few. She was spiritually gifted and had an amazing way of dissecting the Bible and explaining it to others in a way that was easily digestible. She was a true example of how to live a God-centered life and how to be a loyal friend.
