he ever had. She and her sister Dot (aka Thelma and Louise) made record setting sales and fund raisers as co-directors of the Food Ministry. She served God vigorously, with all her might. She was a true nurturer; from God's vegetation and flowers to his children. Everyone who came in her space loved her instantly.
