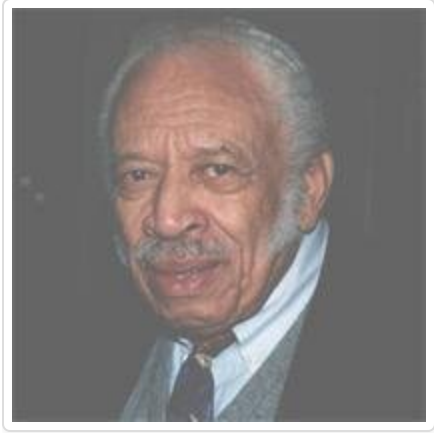




Felix Wilson Haney,
