### John Williams Obituary

Cleveland, OH - John Aaron Williams age 87, was called home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, December 15, 2009. He was born in London, Kentucky on January 16, 1922 to Addie (Malone) and Joseph Williams. He was the fifth of seven brothers. John was baptized at East Mount Zion Baptist Church. He graduated high school in Barboursville, Kentucky and joined the Army in 1942. He received the Good Conduct Medal, WW II Victory Medal, and American Theater Ribbon. After discharge from the Army, John went to Cleveland, Ohio and opened a service station with his brother, Ben in 1949. He later opened Williams Auto Body Shop on Cedar Avenue and East 106. In the early 1960s, he began to teach auto body repair to students at Max Hayes Vocational High School and retired from the Cleveland School District in 1989. John returned to teaching auto body repair at Max Hayes night school and remained there until 1998. Besides being a member of the Cleveland Teachers Union, he was a member of the Lake City Mens Club, Guys and Dolls, and East Mount Zion bowling teams. He loved to dance and he and his wife, Nita attended all the formal functions and danced the latest dances until his health began to fail. To treasure his memory he leaves: a devoted wife, Juanita; four children; Vernice Taylor, Juan (Jaczueline), Eric (Maria) of Montgomery, AL and Michael (Jacqueline); eight grandchildren; Blake, Scott, Sean Bibb, Eric, Juan, Michael, Raymond, and Raychel; eight great-grandchildren, Juanita, Brandon, Felicia, Symone, Brooklyn, Diego, Bianca and Skyera; two great-great
