Keith loved going to camps for the disabled such as Camp Cheerful in Strongsville, Ohio. In later life, he was able to attend camp at his residential area for the disabled.

He was a church member at Mt. Pleasant United Methodist Church in Cleveland, Ohio and Aldersgate United Methodist Church in Warrensville Heights, Ohio. Of most recent, he attended the Church of Warsaw in Ohio. In summary, church was important in Keith's life and was a major deciding factor as where he resided in his later life.

Keith lived life to the fullest and wanted to live among others with similar challenges. Because of this, he moved to Echoing Hills System in mid-1990s

that specialize in enhancing the disabled lives in being productive to society, increase their physical and social abilities, and to foster a Christian environment for ongoing support.

He was always involved in problems concerning the disadvantaged and spent time sending letters to agencies and other advocates to promote the well-being of the disabled.

He enjoyed reading and often spent Saturday mornings reading the World Almanacs and singing songs, with his little sister, Valerie. Most important, Keith loved to discuss politics with those that did not agree with him. He would have debates for hours. Lastly, Keith had an outstanding collection of records, albums, and tapes. He loved all types of music from country, to light pop and classical music and loved to sing.

Keith left behind his wife (Sarah Richards), mother (deceased Mable Green), father (deceased Marvin Green), sister, (Valerie Green Fort), brother-in-law (Dana Fort), niece (Dominique Brown), cherished cousins (Christine and Robin Clay) and a host of relatives and friends.
