On some days when he just wanted to make others laugh, he went outside and walked and ran through Hamshire in Cleveland Heights, and people were so happy

laughing, stopping to take pictures. It was an incident where he walked into a store and a man was going to kill him because he was scared, but it was all fun and games. He was an amazing and funny man.

From 1968 to 1970 Pierre served in the US Army where he furthered his education at the high school during his time in the army, Pierre fought in Vietnam and became a member of the 336 SOC Trang Thunderbirds and received a specialist 5 (SPC 5) rank in 1969 and was awarded numerous medals, souvenirs and heroism in combat. During a battle in Vietnam, Pierre also showed bravery by saving his commanding officers life. Also he served a short time in the Navy in the late 70s.

Pierre met the love of his life Patricia Banks in 1984 they became inseparable. You didn't see one without the other until 2019 in which she preceded him in death.
